SCHOOL PROGRAM REPORTS/DISCUSSION: Rusty Holmes proposed that School Trust Lands Money be used for the 2022-23 school year to sustain and support our Mental Health program by maintaining our mentors. We have Dale Esplin, Liz Wallentine, Kolby Ray & Debbie De Batty. They are assigned to 2 or 3 teachers and work with them to help the students in need.
