School Trust Lands usually funds our school around \$23,000 each year. This year the funds are being used to pay the partial salary for a social worker to be here at the school and help with the Mental Health of our students.

Red Ribbon Day will be October 12th and will focus on Suicide Prevention and a Positive Behavior Plan. The theme is “What Makes Life Worth Living?” There will be an assembly with Matt Clark and activities throughout the day to reinforce the theme. Chick-fil-A will also provide lunch for the students.
